MEDIA BRIEFING ON THE FLOOD RELIEF FUND AND OPERATION VULA FUND

KwaZulu-Natal MEC for Economic Development, Tourism and Environmental Affairs (EDTEA), Mr Siboniso Duma, will visit businesses impacted by the April/May 2022 and February 2023 floods.
