PURPOSE

The purpose of this presentation is to:

- Inform the Provincial Command Council on COVID-19 about the number of confirmed Public Servants that tested positive with COVID-19 and those who passed away within KwaZulu-Natal.
- Provide age analysis of all employees who have succumbed to death due to COVID-19.



DISCUSSION

- The Provincial Command Council resolved that the Office of the Premier must provide a report on the number of employees who have passed on due to COVID-19.
- This report covers Provincial Government, Entities as well as Municipalities. Analysis of Municipalities shows the impact in all 54 local municipalities.
- The Provincial Command Council further requested that the Office of the Premier do an age analysis of all employees who have succumbed to death.
- This report includes fourteen (14) Provincial Departments, sixteen (16) Entities as well as 54 Municipalities.



DISCUSSION

- The Province has **725 employees** who have **succumbed to death** since the eruption of the **pandemic**.

- The Office of the Premier has finalized the process of **age analysis** for all public servants who have succumbed to death.

- The breakdown per department is herein attached as
 - **Provincial Departments;**
 - **Public Entities and**
 - **Municipalities**



DISCUSSION

- Employees from the Provincial Departments, Public Entities as well as Municipalities have been severely affected with outbreak of COVID-19.
- As of today, 10th February 2021, the Province has recorded the following numbers:

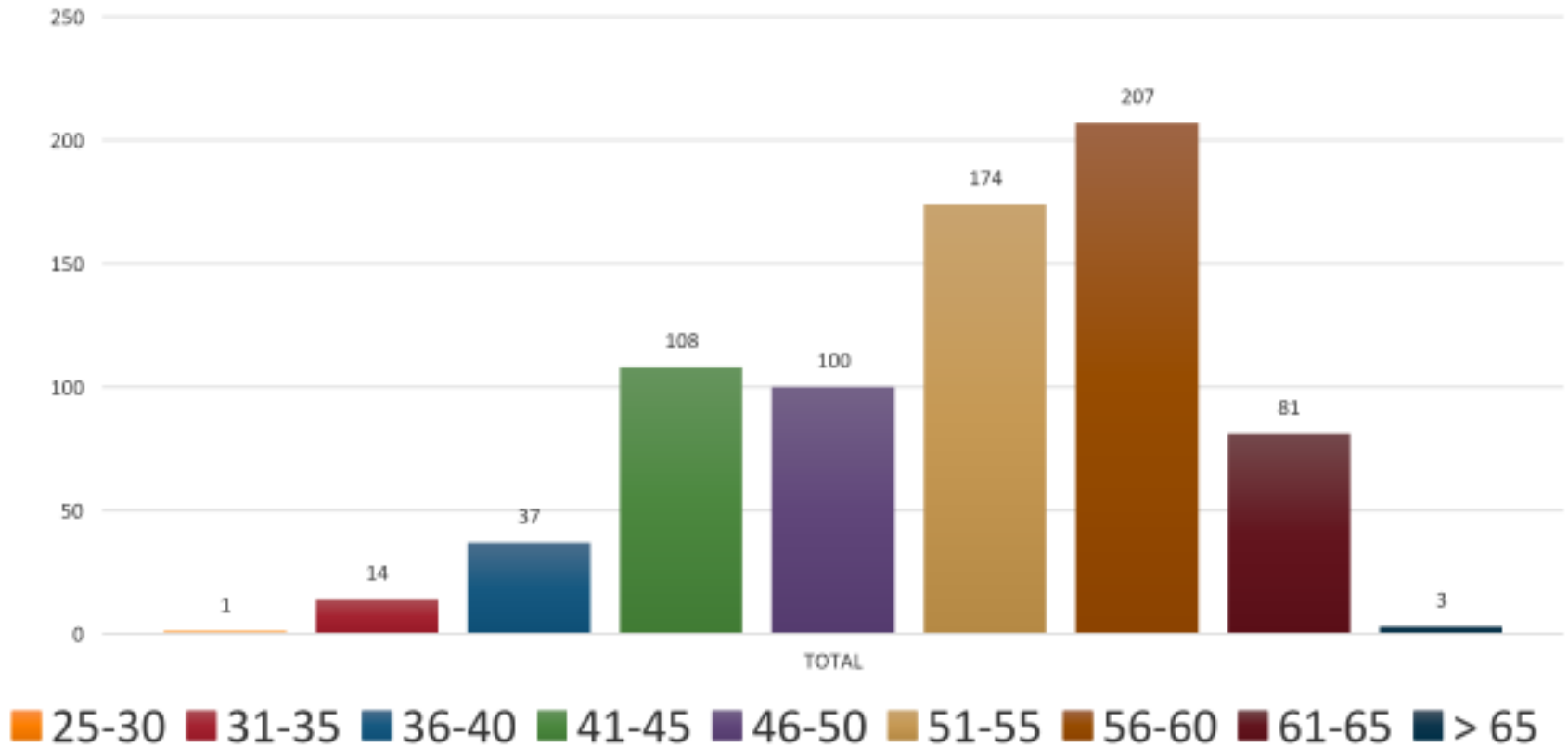

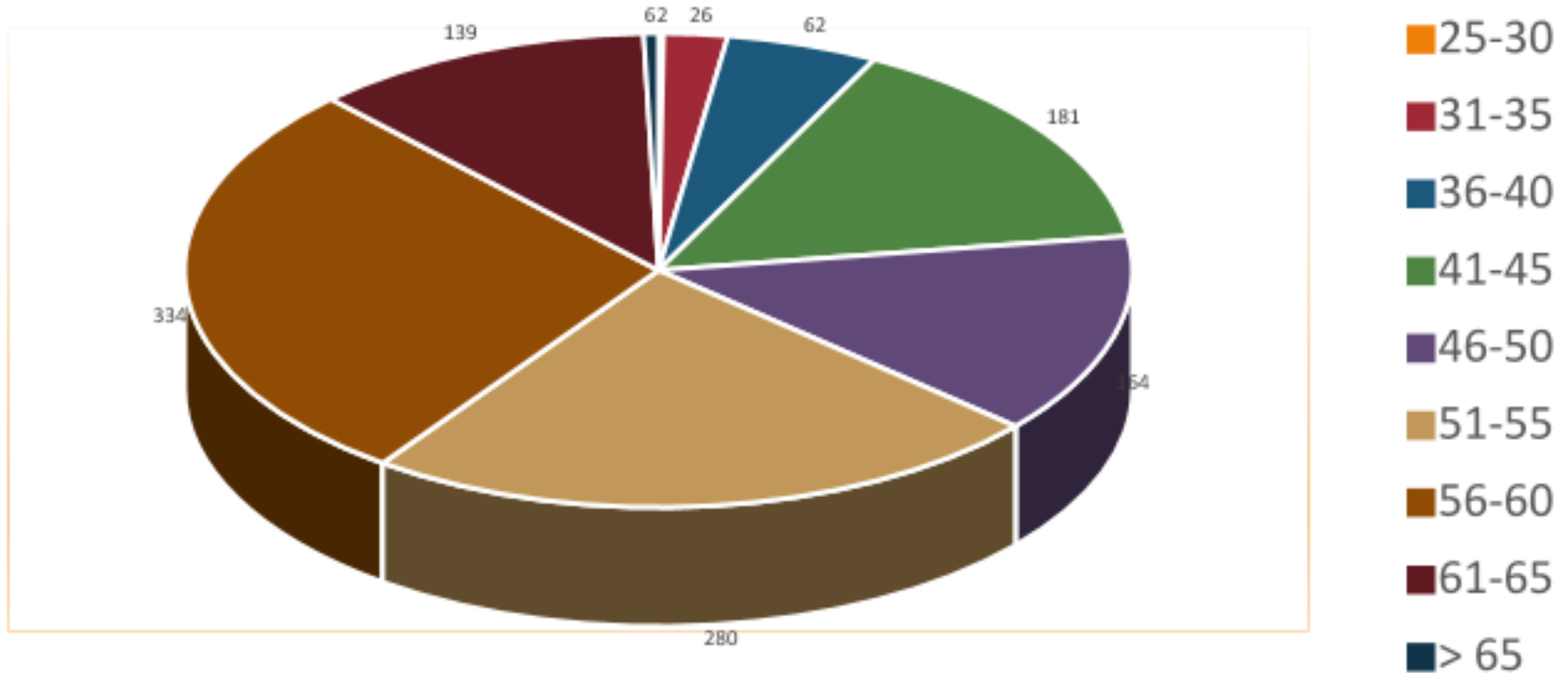

AGE ANALYSIS

- The above report shows that, about **207 (29%)** employees between the ages of **56 years to 60 years** were mostly affected.
- They were followed by the ages of **51 years to 55 years** which constitutes of **174 (24 %)**.
- More than 50 % of employees were between the ages of **46 years to 60 years** of age.



RECOMMENDATION

- It is recommended that the Provincial Command Council on COVID-19 be informed of the number of confirmed employees who tested positive with COVID-19, those who passed away within KwaZulu-Natal as well as their age analysis.
