## INVITATION TO FILL VACANCIES ON THE MOSES KOTANE RESEARCH INSTITUTE BOARD

By the virtue of the powers vested in me as the Member of the KwaZulu-Natal Provincial Executive Council responsible for Economic Development, Tourism and Environmental Affairs and in terms of section 5 of the KwaZulu-Natal Moses Kotane Research Institute Act, 2024 (Act no. 3 of 2024), I hereby invite interested parties within the KwaZulu- Natal Province to nominate candidates for

appointment to the Moses Kotane Research Institute Board. The Moses Kotane Research Institute (MKRI) was established in terms of section 2 5 of the

KwaZulu-Natal Moses Kotane Research Institute Act 2024 (Act no. 03 of 2024) and is a leading research think tank dedicated to advancing socio-economic development, policy formulation and interventions in KwaZulu-Natal. MKRI economic sectors research is geared towards service delivery programmes, promote innovation, coordinates and facilitates training and skills development interventions tailored towards provincial economic growth and development.

To qualify for nomination, the candidate must not be disqualified from being a director of a company, must meet the requirements for appointment as contemplated in section 94 of the Companies Act. 2008 (Act No. 71 of 2008) and must meet the requirements for independence contemplated in the King IV Report on Corporate Governance. Interested parties within the KwaZulu-Natal province are hereby invited to nominate candidates for

appointment to the Moses Kotane Research Institute Board.

To qualify for nomination, nominated persons must:

(a) Have appropriate knowledge and experience in organised constituencies within business of the Institute

- (b) Be fit and proper persons to serve the best interests of Moses Kotane Research Institute, and possess appropriate knowledge or experience in the academic, research or maritime fields, or possess one or more of the following skills and expertise:
- (c) Research and publication skills, experience and qualifications
- (d) Maritime skills, experience and qualifications
- (e) Economic, corporate and public governance skills, experience and qualifications
- (f) Legal skills, experience and qualifications; and
- (g) Financial and auditing skills, experience and qualifications
- (h) Not be disqualified from being appointed as a Board Member as stipulated in section 6 of the KwaZulu-Natal Moses Kotane Research Institute Act, 2024 (Act no. 3 of 2024).

Nominations of individuals representing the following sectors are encouraged:

- (a) Tertiary institutions
- (b) Research institutions
- (c) Stakeholders in the economic sector
- (d) The legal sector
- (e) Business: and
- The financial sector.
- A nominator, providing substantive motivation, must nominate the proposed candidate in writing,
- and the proposed candidate must accept such nomination in writing, in addition to which the nominee must submit:
- (a) A detailed Curriculum Vitae (CV)
- (b) Certified copies of qualifications
- (c) Certified identity document
- (d) An affidavit that she or he is not disqualified from being a director; and
- (e) Supporting information and contact details of at least two (2) references failing which the nominee will be disqualified and will not be considered for appointment.
