The media is central in creating an informed and participatory citizenry, and together with bona fide media houses, we must stamp out fake news."

Duma added, "An informed public is crucial to any operating democracy, and incorrect information is significantly damaging in the news which appears to be authentic. We are cautioning people to refrain from spreading fake news as government policies are misrepresented on this fake news."
