PREMIER DUBE-NCUBE TO UPDATE CITIZENS ON PERTINENT DEVELOPMENTS FOLLOWING PROVINCIAL EXECUTIVE COUNCIL MEETING

The KwaZulu-Natal Premier Nomusa Dube-Ncube will on Thursday, 13 July 2023, hold a media briefing to update citizens on matters related to interventions to combat disruptions by construction mafias, illegal invasion of state-owned houses, torching of trucks and addressing energy issues following engagements with the Minister of Electricity Dr Kgosientsho Ramokgopa during today's Executive Council meeting.

The briefing will also present the state of readiness for the reopening of schools and measures to ensure the uninterrupted supply of food in schools next week.

This week also marks two years since we witnessed scenes of wanton destruction which swept through parts of KwaZulu-Natal and Gauteng provinces as part of the July unrest, resulting in the loss of 354 lives.

Premier Dube-Ncube, who will be joined by Members of the Executive Council; namely MEC for Economic Development, Tourism and Environmental Affairs Siboniso Duma, MEC for Education Mbali Frazer and MEC for Human Settlements and Public Works Sipho "KK" Nkosi, will also detail outcomes of the Provincial Executive Council meeting which ended late this evening.
